Where students have no scheduled exam for a day, they are permitted to stay at home and study for the next exam. Students are also permitted to leave school at the conclusion of the morning exam if they only have one exam in the day.

The evening commenced with a Subject Market, where teachers had set up subject stalls displaying materials, texts and equipment relating to their respective subjects.
