The selection process will be by written application and a panel interview.

The written application will include:

- In addition to the application form, a student written 300 to 500 word essay indicating the student's special interests, achievements as outlined in the criteria, and the contribution the student would make to the life of the College. (To be submitted as part of the application).
- Two reference (other than parents) letters supporting the candidate's chosen activities.
- The applicant's most recent school report and NAPLAN test results.

6. DECLARATION

I understand that if I am selected as one of the recipients of the Mar Meelis Scholarship at St Narsai Assyrian Christian College, the scholarship is conditional on the following:

1. A scholarship holder will endeavour to maintain a high level of academic achievement.
2. In all areas of school life, a scholarship holder must be a positive role model and fully support the ethos and values of the College.
3. A scholarship holder's performance will be reviewed annually in terms of their all-round performance in both academic and co-curricular studies. Failure to perform may result in a cancellation of the scholarship for the second year.
4. If you are successful your scholarship can cover tuition fees to the value of 50% or 100%. The decision will be made by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship covers tuition fees only for Year 5 & 6 for Year 5 scholarship recipients Years 7 & 8 for Year 7 scholarship recipients, Years 9 & 10 for Year 9 scholarship recipients and Years 11 & 12 for Year 11 scholarship recipients.
5. I am currently **enrolled** at St Hurmizd Assyrian Primary School or St Narsai Assyrian Christian College.

Note: Should you leave St Narsai the scholarship will no longer be valid at another school. Scholarship recipients will be subject to annual review of their academic achievements and extra-curricular involvements. Applications for 2026 Scholarships close Friday 8th August 2025.

Note: If you are successful for a 2026 scholarship, a Conditional Offer will be offered. However, your scholarship will only be awarded if you meet all the conditions in your offer letter.

All applicants will be considered by the Scholarship Committee and decisions are final.
